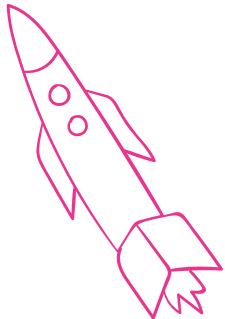




# "May There Always Be" COMMUNITY STORYBOOK PROJECT WITH JIM GILL

- ❑ Create the artwork for your page of this book.
- ❑ Please write your first name on your page.
- ❑ Have an adult scan or take a photo of your page and have them email that image to [youthprogramming@carmel.lib.in.us](mailto:youthprogramming@carmel.lib.in.us).
- ❑ Please only send one image per child.
- ❑ Make sure the library receives the image of your book page by **January 31, 2021**.
